<p><u>Level 1 Behaviors</u> Behaviors include but are not limited to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disrespect to classmate • Disrespect to staff • Running in halls/unsafe hallway manners • Tardiness • Inappropriate Language • Minor disruption of class • Teasing • Not following directions • Inappropriate gestures • Minor misuse of technology/property 	<p><u>Level 1 Responses to Behaviors</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handled by teacher/staff member • <u>Review rules/expectations</u> • Practice procedures as needed • Complete Think Sheet process • Enter minor referral into SWIS • Reestablish relationship with student 	<p><u>Consequence Options</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Private meeting with teacher -Think Sheet and conversation -Parent/guardian contact
<p><u>Level 2 Behaviors</u> Behaviors include but are not limited to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arguing with another student or staff • Refusal to complete assigned work • Cheating/lying • Defiance • Throwing objects • Minor Physical Contact (Pushing/Hitting/Pinching) • Property/Technology Misuse 	<p><u>Level 2 Responses to Behaviors</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handled by teacher/staff member • <u>Contact parent/guardian</u> by teacher • Reteach expectations • Conference with student (may include support staff/counselor if needed) • Enter minor into SWIS • If behavior happens 3x in a month= Major Referral • Reestablish relationship with student 	<p><u>Consequence Options</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Private meeting with teacher -Think Sheet and conversation -Student talk with parent/guardian -Teacher/Students Check in with principal -Loss of Privilege/Activity
<p><u>Level 3 Behaviors</u> Behaviors include but are not limited to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fighting • Intent to injure another person • Theft (less than \$50) • Bus Misconduct • Racial Comments • Spitting/Biting/Throwing objects intending to hurt someone • Bullying • Destruction of Property • Threats • Harassment (sexual or verbal) • Damaging school or personal property • Abusive Language 	<p><u>Level 3 Response to Behaviors</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handled by administration • Direct Office Referral • Major Referral entered in SWIS by teacher/staff • Parent Contact by administrations and meeting (if needed) • Student Resource Officer and/or Law Enforcement involved if necessary • Referral to Tier 2 Team • Reestablish relationship with student 	<p><u>Consequence Options</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Conference meeting with parents/guardians, teacher, counselor, administration -Creation of behavior plan -Loss of privilege/activities -Fines assessed if necessary -School Service (with parent consent)
<p><u>Level 4 Behaviors - Zero Tolerance</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Illegal Drugs • Alcohol/Tobacco Possession and/or Use • Dangerous Weapons (real or fake) • Arson • Theft (over \$50) • Leaving School Without Permission • Assault with bodily harm • Extreme threat (bomb or shooting) • Obscene sexual misconduct 	<p><u>Level 4 Response to Behaviors</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handled by administration • Direct Office Referral • Major Referral entered in SWIS by teacher/staff • Parent Contact by administrations and meeting (if needed) • Student Resource Officer and/or Law Enforcement involved if necessary • Referral to Tier 2 Team • Reestablish relationship with student 	<p><u>Consequence Options</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Conference meeting with parents/guardians, teacher, counselor, administration -Creation of behavior plan -Loss of privilege/activities -Fines assessed if necessary -School Service (with parent consent) -In-school suspension -Out of School Suspension -Expulsion
